What's New at UCP's Shuttle Department?

UCP's Shuttle department is a unique kind of transportation service that UCP provides for folks that are unable to walk to a bus stop to ride public transportation. Shuttle is helping to provide freedom

to individuals with disabilities, the elderly, seniors, veterans and many others. We provide a Safe, Friendly and Reliable Service that allows our clients to experience life without limits. In one year alone our Shuttle Department has driven 50,000 miles, enough to drive around the earth 2 times. When compared to all of Paratransit drivers, UCP's Shuttle drivers are in the top 10 percent in on-time performance.

In 2011 UCP operated just 12 Shuttle routes each day. Today they are operating 25 routes per day. Last year alone, Shuttle helped transport more than 30,000 passengers.
