## ESSENTIAL SERVICE NOTICE

To Law Enforcement and/or Food and Supply Business:

UCP of Sacramento and Northern California (UCP) is a social-service non-profit that provides essential supports and services to individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, many of whom are medically fragile or who require support to be safe during this crisis. These services have been identified as an essential service under one or more the following categories under Executive Order N-33-20:

- *Workers who provide support to vulnerable populations to ensure their health and well-being including family care providers*
- *Workers supporting public and private childcare establishments, pre-K establishments, K-12 schools, colleges, and universities for purposes of distance learning, provision of school meals, or care and supervision of minors to support essential workforce across all sectors*
- *Workers that provide or determine eligibility for food, shelter, in-home supportive services, child welfare, adult protective services and social services, and other necessities of life for economically disadvantaged or otherwise needy individuals (including family members)*

Our employees are authorized to work and travel to provide critical support to clients and their families during this State of Emergency. UCP provides services in Sacramento, Placer, El Dorado, Yolo, and Nevada counties. If you have any questions, you can contact me at 916-283-8305.
